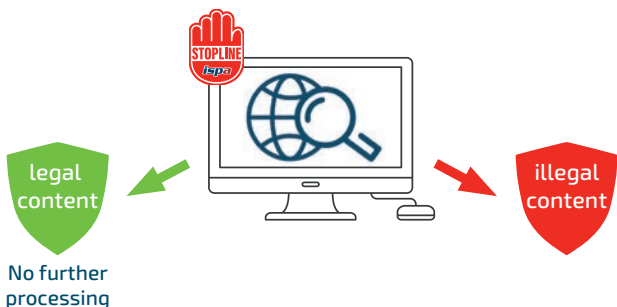

2. WHAT CONTENT IS CONSIDERED ILLEGAL?

Stopleveline checks every reported content to determine whether it violates the legal provisions on Child Sexual Abuse Material or National Socialism.



Based on the long-term average, around 25 % of the reports received are classified as illegal.

The majority of illegal reports concern Child Sexual Abuse Material, with a small proportion relating to National Socialism.

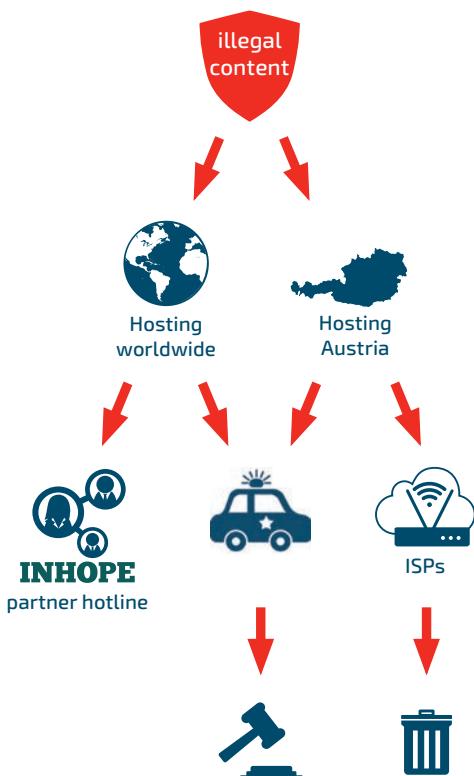

3. HOW DOES STOPLINE WORK?

Our primary goal is the rapid **removal of content** that has been reported and **classified as illegal** by Stopleveline from the Internet.

This is done by notifying the host providers, whose technical systems are used to place the content on the Internet, either directly by Stopleveline or an INHOPE partner hotline.

At the same time, the responsible law enforcement authority receives all necessary information about the illegal content in order to secure all relevant evidence that can contribute to the investigation of possible perpetrators.
